- Poll Watchers or State Inspectors
- Representative of local political subdivisions for which the county is conducting an election (if applicable)
- County party chairs (if applicable)
- Sheriff's deputy or other security person

Access Prohibited: At the close of business or approximately 5pm

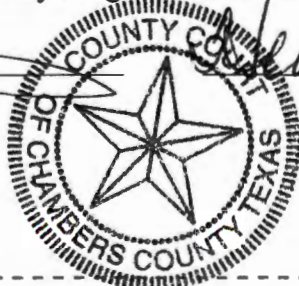
