**JOB SUMMARY AND PRINCIPAL DUTIES:** Responsible for overseeing children in/out the pool. Provide swimming lessons, provide guidance and assistance to other lifeguards and other safety techniques. Attend in-service training weekly. Enforce pool rules. Report all maintenance request and safety hazards to Supervisor. Responsible for daily income. Responsible for cleaning the pool area, restrooms, & outside premises. Perform all other lifeguard responsibilities as assigned.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 16 years of age or older;
- Sufficient education to understand, interpret and follow instructions.
- Must be able to swim 300 yards without stopping, and at a steady pace;
- The 300 yards consists of 100 yards freestyle/front crawl and/or breaststroke;
- Must be able to complete a surface dive at 7 to 10 feet of depth, pick up a 10 pound diving brick, return to the surface, & swim 20 yards with the brick and head above water;
- Must be able to tread water for 2 minutes using legs only;
- Must pass a prerequisites swim try-out with swim coach, after passing swim test you will be e-mailed access to a 7-hours online home study course;
- Complete and print out Certificate of Completion;
- Must be able to attend ARC Lifeguard & CPR for the Professional Rescuer Classes:  
April (27<sup>th</sup> 5pm-8pm, 28<sup>th</sup> 8am-8pm, 29<sup>th</sup> 8am-8pm) or May (4<sup>th</sup> 5pm-8pm, 5<sup>th</sup> 8am-8pm, 6<sup>th</sup> 8am-8pm)
