JOB SUMMARY AND PRINCIPAL DUTIES: Responsible for overseeing, opening and closing pool. Schedule lifeguards at the facility. Provide guidance and assistance to other lifeguards in surveillance and other safety techniques. Provide in-service training to all lifeguard staff. Enforce pool rules. Report all maintenance request and safety hazards to Maintenance Department. Responsible for daily income and the reporting of all monies to County Treasurer's office. Perform all other lifeguard responsibilities. Also performs other related duties, as may be assigned.

REQUIREMENTS:

- A valid Texas Driver license/acceptable driving record.
- Sufficient education to understand, interpret and follow instructions.
- 16 years of age or older;
- Must be able to swim 300 yards without stopping, and at a steady pace;
- The 300 yards consists of 100 yards freestyle/front crawl and/or breaststroke;
- Must be able to complete a surface dive at 7 to 10 feet of depth, pick up a 10 pound diving brick, return to the surface, & swim 20 yards with the brick and head above water;
- Must be able to tread water for 2 minutes using legs only;
- Must pass a prerequisites swim try-out with swim coach, after passing swim test you will be e-mailed access to a 7-hours online home study course;
- Complete and print out Certificate of Completion;
- Must be able to attend ARC Lifeguard & CPR for the Professional Rescuer Classes:
April (27th 5pm-8pm, 28th 8am-8pm, 29th 8am-8pm) or May (4th 5pm-8pm, 5th 8am-8pm, 6th 8am-8pm)
