The Court heard an update from HO+K regarding the Women's Detention Center (Project 1) and the Justice Center (Project 2).


For the record, Commissioner Hammond entered courtroom at 2:07 p.m. and Commissioner Gore entered at 2:24 p.m.

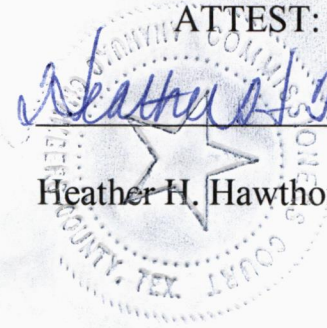
Court returned to Regular Session at 4:58 p.m. No action was taken following Executive Session.
