Job Summary:

Inspector in the Division of Mosquito Control under supervision, this position performs routine inspections and comprehensive investigations to determine compliance with the Structural Pest Control Act and other state and federal laws. Inspection sites often include basements, attics, crawl spaces, county owned parks, marshes, rice fields, ditches and buildings.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

- Vector Control; Provide technical expertise to the regulated community and public
- Perform inspections in field and marsh sites
- Perform public health pest control as need; inspect specific areas
- Identify pests and pest related issues
- Operate and maintain service vehicle, and other service equipment per county guidelines.
- Utilize, secure, and store products and materials in accordance with labels, government and county guidelines.
- Maintain licenses, certifications, and/or registrations and required; participate in training as directed.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience in pest management, agriculture or environmental protection or a professional position working with pesticide;
- Experience in regulatory enforcement of pesticide laws affecting the environment;
- Working knowledge of scientific and technical principles applicable to pesticide usage as well as knowledge of laws and regulations relevant to the handling of pesticides;
- Experience with inspection/investigation procedures;
- Exceptional skills related to oral/written communication and public relations
- Demonstrated team orientation aptitude, flexibility and desire for constant improvement;
