Job Summary and Principal Duties:

Assist in managing the daily operations at the county landfill and collection stations, including monitoring and documenting present utilization of landfill, monitors heavy equipment utilized in the disposal of solid waste, ensuring proper disposal of solid waste as specified by state and county regulations.

- Directs Equipment Operators, Landfill Maintenance Personnel, Collection Station Attendants, Roll Off Truck Drivers, Tub Grinding Crew and Collection Station Maintenance Workers.
- Ensures county policies pertaining to solid waste are efficiently and effectively executed.
- Maintains daily, weekly, and monthly records within the landfill as required by the county and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must possess a Class A Municipal Solid Waste Operator License from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality or the ability to obtain certificate within six months of employment.
2. *Skill/Ability to: ensure compliance with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality standards for solid waste.*
3. *Knowledge of: county and solid waste disposal rules, regulations and procedures; the provisions of the Texas Motor Vehicle Code pertaining to the safe operations of heavy equipment; and supervisory techniques.*
4. High school diploma, or its equivalent, plus at least five years of experience in sanitation operations, including experience operating heavy equipment and at least one year of supervisory experience or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
5. Appropriate Texas Driver License.
6. Any applicant conditionally selected for this position will be required to submit to a physical and drug testing, before commencing employment.
