Public Health Updates

As of 12 p.m. on March 20, 2020 there are no confirmed positive cases in Chambers County.

Federal Updates

The President of the United States has issued Coronavirus Guidelines for America titled "15 Days to Slow the Spread." This guide is available at whitehouse.gov.

State Updates

State of Texas Governor Abbot issued Executive Orders on March 19, 2020 mandating that all citizens:

- Avoid social gatherings in groups of more than 10 people (**including church**)
- Avoid eating or drinking at bars, restaurants and food courts or visiting gyms or massage parlors (drive through, pick up and delivery at restaurants is allowed and highly encouraged)
- Shall not visit nursing homes, retirement or long-term care facilities unless to provide critical assistance
- Additionally, all schools shall temporarily close.

County Updates

Per Executive Order from County Judge Jimmy Sylvia, the following mandates are currently in place:

- Twenty-four (24) hour curfew for all individuals under the age of 18 who are not in school; are not accompanied by school personnel, a parent or guardian; or are not going directly to or home from their place of employment
- A person shall not sell any goods or services for more than the price the person charged for the goods or services on March 12, 2020 in ANY area within Chambers County

Chambers County Office Closures
