Public Health Updates

As of March 25, 2020 there are two confirmed cases in Chambers County.

The next two weeks are critical in slowing the spread of COVID-19. Stay home as much as possible. Limit close contact (six feet) with others. If you are sick or have mild symptoms, stay home and call your Primary Care Provider. If you feel like you have severe symptoms and need to go to the ER, please call ahead.

State Updates

Governor Abbott's Executive Orders from March 19, 2020 mandated that all citizens avoid:

- Social gatherings in groups of more than 10 people (including private gatherings and church)
- Dining in or drinking at bars, restaurants and food courts or visiting massage parlors, gyms or and nail salons (drive through, pick up and delivery at restaurants is allowed and highly encouraged)
- Nursing homes, retirement or long-term care facilities unless to provide critical assistance
- Additionally, all schools shall temporarily close

County Updates

Per Executive Order from County Judge Jimmy Sylvia, the following mandates are currently in place:

- **All individuals residing in Chambers County are ordered to stay at their place of residence except for Essential Activities defined in the Judge's March 24 Executive Order (see Order for more information)**
- **All businesses operating within Chambers County EXCEPT those identified as essential (see Order for more information) are ordered to cease operation**
- Citizens shall not visit tattoo parlors, beauty salons and barber shops
- It is a crime for a person to sell any goods or services for more than the price the person charged for the goods or services on March 12, 2020 in ANY area within Chambers County. Price gouging should be report to the Chambers County Sheriff's Office at 409-267-2500
