Chambers County Library System Libraries Return to Curbside Service Only

Beginning Monday, June 29, 2020 all Chambers County Library System Branches will return to curbside service only.

“Due to the dramatic increase in positive cases of COVID-19 in Chambers County, we feel that closing all library branches and returning to curbside service only is the best option for protecting both our employees and clients,” said Chambers County Judge Jimmy Sylvia.

Curbside service will be available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Items can be reserved online at <https://chambers.lib.tx.us/> or by telephone. Clients should call the library when they arrive to pick up their items, open the trunk or back seat and then get back into the vehicle. Library staff will place items directly into the trunk or seat and close the door.

Printing and fax services will also be offered via curbside.

After use, library items must be returned to the outdoor drop box at the closest Chambers County Library System Branch. Returned items will be quarantined for 14 days before they are available again for check out.

All Chambers County residents are encouraged to remember that we must all work together to slow the spread of COVID-19. Staying home when possible, wearing a mask when in public and frequently washing your hands are all essential to protecting your family, community and yourself.
