



NOTICE OF 2018 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR CHAMBERS COUNTY, TEXAS

A tax rate of \$0.542548 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of Chambers County. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate. The governing body of Chambers County proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of increase local law enforcement, upgrade county parks and county buildings, replace aging equipment, and increase county personnel.

PRECEDING YEAR'S TAX RATE	\$0.542548 per \$100
EFFECTIVE TAX RATE	\$0.523742 per \$100
ROLLBACK TAX RATE	\$0.561430 per \$100

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Chambers County from the same properties in both the 2017 tax year and the 2018 tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that Chambers County may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE ABOVE RATES CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
