These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by **Chambers County**.

**REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

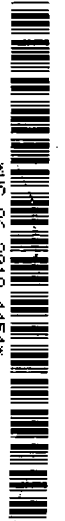
On or about **November 28, 2018**, **Chambers County**, will submit a request to the General Land Office (GLO) for the release of Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds under Section 104 (F) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended to undertake a projects known as **Smith Point Water Line and Booster - DRS210024-A401 A1** for the purpose of **ensuring the community has adequate water service**.

**Description of Project:**

Grantee shall purchase and install seventy-eight thousand two hundred seventy linear feet (78,270 l.f.) of six-inch (6 in.) diameter waterline; two thousand four hundred linear feet (2,400 l.f.) of ten-inch (10 in.) diameter waterline; ten (10) six-inch (6 in.) gate valves; four (4) ten-inch (10 in.) gate valves; one (1) five thousand gallon (5,000 gal.) pressure tank; one chloramine (disinfectant) booster station; water line connections and all associated appurtenances. There is no acquisition associated with this project.

All work will occur in Chambers County, Texas. Construction shall take place in the following locations: Eagle Ferry Road from FM 562 to Haynes Road - 7,000 lf; Haynes Road from Eagle Ferry Road - 9,500 lf to the East Fork of Double Bayou; Existing TBCD Easement from the East Fork of Double Bayou to FM 562; Linear Feet - 7,000 lf; FM 562 from Existing TBCD Easement to Whitehead Road Linear Feet; 56,780; Whitehead Road from FM 562 to Existing TBCD Booster Station Linear Feet 390; Existing TBCD Bstr Station to 112 Whitehead Road - Public Facility.

**Total Grant Amount:** Project will cost \$2,718,948 and will be paid for with HUD CDBG-DR grant funds administered by the Texas General Land Office.



## FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

**Chambers County** has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at **the Chambers County Courthouse, 404 Washington Avenue, Anahuac, Texas 77514** and may be examined or copied weekdays 9 A.M to 4 P.M.

## PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to **Chambers County Courthouse, 404 Washington Avenue, Anahuac, Texas 77514**. All comments received by **November 27, 2018** or within eighteen (18) days following this posting (whichever is later) will be considered by **Chambers County** prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comment's should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

## ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

**Chambers County** certifies to GLO that **Jimmy Sylvia** in his capacity as **County Judge** consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. GLO's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows **Chambers County** to use Program funds.

## OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

GLO will accept objections to its release of fund and **Chambers County's** certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of **Chambers County**; (b) **Chambers County** has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by GLO; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Community Development and Revitalization Program, General Land Office at Texas Disaster Recovery Program 3429 Executive Center Drive, Suite 150, Austin, TX 78731. Potential objectors should contact GLO to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
