Introduction:

The purpose of this cook off is to raise money for the Annual Chambers County Youth Livestock Show and Ranch Rodeo. This foundation has been created to help provide Chamber's County youth scholarships for their participation in projects ranging from livestock to culinary arts.

Administration:

1. There will be a limit of 30 teams. Registration begins February 27, 2019. Entries should be submitted by April 1, 2019. Forms can be hand delivered or mailed to:

Spaces will be on a 1st come 1st serve basis. Forms available at www.co.chambers.tx.us

2. Check in is April 25, 2019 starting at 5pm under pavilion. All meat will be inspected as soon as you check-in. Once teams are checked in they can start setting up and cooking.

3. Each team will be given a 40'x40' space as spots are allowed. Teams are responsible for cleaning & policing their own area. Trash bins will be placed throughout the contest area for contestants to use.

4. Teams should conduct themselves in a manner that is suitable for family participation. The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and invited guests. **Under NO circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to minors.** Teams are welcome to bring in their own alcohol, however glass bottles are prohibited. All music must be held at a moderate level while in the contest area. NO Bands allowed. Consideration to your fellow cooks and livestock & rodeo goers is a must. Any contestant or team member who displays indecent signs or apparel or who are excessively loud will be asked to leave the contest area and forfeit their entry fee.
5. All Chambers County Youth Livestock Show and Ranch Rodeo committee members have free access to all contestant tents & we ask that if you have extra food that you please feed them as a courtesy. These people volunteer their time for the kids so please show your appreciation. There is to be no selling of any alcohol, food or any other goods. We have concessions & vendors on the grounds and we do not want to compete with them.
6. NO golf carts, ATV'S, etc. allowed on grounds.
7. All teams must provide at least 1 judge per category.
8. There will be no refund for weather or any natural disaster.
9. Please make all checks to CCYLSRR.
10. Texas Union Band will play Friday night under pavilion where check-in is free of charge. Saturday night Shotgun Rider, Rance May & the Coyotes and Honky Tonk Jones will play in White's Park Community Building. There is an entry fee for this concert.

Cooking:

NO contest meals can be cooked, salted, marinated, or seasoned prior to arrival at cook off. Upon check-in you will be provided containers to turn in food. No other containers will be accepted. No marking of containers of any sort or your team will be disqualified with no refund.

Categories:

Chicken (1/2 of a whole fully jointed chicken)
Pork Spare Ribs (7 full ribs cut apart)
Brisket (7 Full slices 1/4 to 3/8 thick)
Rice (provided container full)
Dessert (provided container full)
Chili (provided container full with NO RICE)
