What is the Brazos Valley Community Action Program?

BVCAP is a first come, first served program that provides assistance for food and utility payments.

Who is eligible to participate?

Chambers County residents whose income level does not exceed 125 percent of poverty level are eligible to apply. See the chart below with the maximum gross income to household size ration.

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Gross Monthly Income</u>
1	\$1,329.16
2	\$1,795.83
3	\$2,262.50
4	\$2,729.16
5	\$3,195.83
6	\$3,662.50
7	\$4,129.16
8	\$4,129.16

Add \$466.66 for each additional household member.

What documents do I need in order to apply?

Applicants must provide proof of identification, residence and income. Acceptable documents include:

- Acceptable Identification Documents: Drivers License, State Issued ID Card, Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, Shot Record, Voter Registration Card
- Acceptable Proof of Residence: Utility Bill (name on bill must match the name on the ID presented), Voter Registration Card, Rent Receipt (including date and physical address where applicant resides) or a Letter from Landlord
- Acceptable Proof of Income: Check Stub, Award Letter, Note from Employer, other (Must Show Be Dated Within Last 30 Days)

APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED - NO WALK INS WILL BE SEEN DUE TO COVID-19
ALL APPLICANTS MUST WEAR A MASK AND SUBMIT TO A HEALTH SCREENING BEFORE BEING ALLOWED ENTRY
ONLY ONE MEMBER PER FAMILY IS PERMITTED INSIDE OF THE BUILDING EXCEPT WHEN NECESSITATED BY DISABILITY
